Registration Information:

- Regional Classic entries open April 1, 2018 at www.juniorsimmental.org.
 - ◆ Early bird deadline: May 7, 2018 at 4:30 pm Mountain time, after which fees double.
 - ◆ Final deadline: May 14, 2018 at 4:30 pm Mountain time. Fees are double.
- Exhibitor registration fee of \$25 includes t-shirt.
- Cattle fees will be \$75 each for heifers, steers, or bulls, and \$100 for cow/calf pairs. Cattle will tie on one side of the aisle with tack on the other. If more room is needed, extra stalls will be \$75.
- Extra exhibitor t-shirts are available for \$15.
- Meal tickets are \$10. Exhibitors should indicate total number of family members on registration for accurate meal counts.
- No cattle are allowed in the barns on Tuesday.
- Bedding in the barn is provided. Exhibitors may bring bedding for tie outs or may purchase wood chips, shavings, or straw on the ISF grounds.
- Generators are encouraged.
- Exhibitors may bring panels for pens or may tie out to the cyclone fence in designated areas only.
- Exhibitors may not tie to trailers. Trailer parking in designated area only.
- Food vendors will be available on the grounds for meals not provided.
- Show supply vendors will be available on the grounds.
- Golf carts are permitted on the grounds but must be registered with the ISF Office for \$25.
- ATVs are not allowed on the ISF grounds.
