

Showmanship - Substitute Animal Request

This option is for exhibitors who check in only a bull. If you check in a heifer, steer or cow/calf pair, this request will be immediately denied.

Bulls may not be used in showmanship. An exhibitor who enters and/or checks in ONLY a bull may apply for approval by the AJSA Board of Trustees to use another exhibitor's animal in Showmanship.

Further, the following rules apply:

- 1. Written application, using this form, must be received by on-site ASA staff before 7 pm on the day of check-in.
- 2. An animal may not be used by multiple exhibitors in Showmanship at the same AJSA Classic.
- 3. The same animal must be used for all phases of Showmanship.
- 4. Animals being used in Showmanship must be entered in the Cattle Show.
- 5. Any exhibitor who checks in a heifer, cow/calf pair or steer is not eligible for this exemption.
- 6. Any exhibitor who checks in no cattle is not eligible for this exemption.
- 7. All other Showmanship rules, as printed in the AJSA Regional and National Classic Rules, must be met.
